Student Lockers

- Students are issued a school locker to keep their personal belongings in during the school day. Locks are not permitted on school lockers. Any locks will be immediately cut-off.
- Students are expected to keep their school lockers clean and uncluttered throughout the entire school year.
- Most lockers will be located within a student's academic team area.
- Lockers and other school property may be subject to inspection and/or search at any time whether or not the student assigned to the locker is present.
- Students may not change from their assigned locker without permission from a teacher and/or principal.

Music Lockers

- Students who play a woodwind, smaller brass instrument, and/or a violin or viola will be issued a music locker to store their instruments at school.
- The school will provide combination locks for these lockers.

Student Valuables

- Students should not bring items of value to school such as phones, jewelry, expensive clothing, electronic equipment, etc.
- The school is not liable for any loss or damage to personal valuables.
- General Rule – Leave your valuables at home if you do not want it lost, stolen, or broken.

Personal Electronic Devices

- Students are personally and solely responsible for the care and security of their electronic devices. **WHILE NOT IN USE, ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE TO BE POWERED OFF AND STORED IN THE STUDENT'S LOCKER.** The Board assumes no responsibility for theft, loss, damage or vandalism to EDs brought onto its property, or the unauthorized use of such devices.
- Students are prohibited from using EDs to capture, record or transmit the words (i.e. audio) and/or images (i.e. pictures/video) of any student, staff member or other person in the school or while attending a school-related activity, without express prior notice and explicit consent for the capture, recording or transmission of such words or images.
- **EDS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THOSE WITH CAMERAS, MAY NOT BE POSSESSED, ACTIVATED OR UTILIZED AT ANY TIME IN ANY SCHOOL SITUATION WHERE A REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF PERSONAL PRIVACY EXISTS.** These locations and circumstances include, but are not limited to locker rooms, shower facilities, restrooms, etc.



- TECH Free Areas
 - The Commons (i.e., cafeteria) during the school day (7:45 am - 2:45 pm)
 - Playground & inside recess
 - Restrooms & locker rooms
 - Stairwells
 - Transition times
- Electronic device infractions will be addressed by:
 - First Referral – Conference warning, parent/guardian notification, item confiscated, and student must pick up device after school in the office.
 - Second Referral – Loss of privilege (ex. recess, detention, before/after school activity, etc.), parent/guardian notification, item confiscated, and parent/guardian must pick up device from the office.
 - Third Referral – Detention, Friday Night School or In-school Suspension, parent/guardian notification, item confiscated and parent must pick up device from the office.
 - Fourth Referral – Consequences based on administrator's discretion.

Change of Schedule Requests

- Students must complete the Change of Schedule Request form to request a change to their exploratory class schedule. The last day to make a request is Friday, August 23.
