Principal's Report

Treasurer's Report

Craft Show

- November 10th
- Table prices were raised this year. There was only 1 complaint about this increase.
- Pizza, doughnuts and coffee were sold.
- Will need someone to chair the event next year. We will reach out to HPI in hopes of getting an incoming 7th grade parent.
- 40 vendors set up; could increase to 50.
- HIPP table sold several items and received great feedback.

Book Fair

- Looked into other company options for next year.
 - Scholastic gives 50% back in Scholastic dollars when sales are \$2500 and above. When sales are below \$2500 the return is 40% in Scholastic dollars. They also give the option to take a check, but again the profit is reduced.
 - Barnes & Noble gives 10% of sales back in gift cards. They do not set up in the schools; parents would have to go into the store on a designated day(s).
 - Follet Book Fairs gives 20% back.
 - Joseph Beth Booksellers give 30% back.
 - Usborne Books has not returned our calls.

- Suggested to check into Blue Ribbon Book fairs.
- How many days should we hold the fair next year?
 - 4 days seems to be best; set up Monday shopping open Tue Thurs.
- We have had some requests for books from a couple teachers:
 - Social Studies 30 books per teacher (3 teachers).
 - Kruger science books

- Would be held over a 2 3 day period.
- Start collecting books from January March and hold the fair in April.
