District Open Enrollment

Please note that the Intradistrict Open Enrollment for the 2018–2019 school year will begin on May 15, 2018 online only through the Perrysburg Schools website. The online link will not be available until May 15. If you do not have a computer you may go to Central Office, 140 E. Indiana Avenue where you may use a kiosk. Consideration for applicants will be done on a first come first serve basis, and in consideration of class size (enrollment). In addition, all applications need to be submitted online no later than June 3, 2018 to be considered. Parents will receive notification of acceptance or rejection via email by June 30, 2018.



Medications

Attention Parents: Please pick up any remaining medication stored in the school clinic by May 24, 2018. After this date, the clinic staff will properly dispose of any medication left in the clinic.

The Perrysburg Schools medication policy requires that a new medication form be filled out for each school year. Careful planning now will help in the transition of the new school year and accommodate any medication adjustments that may have taken place over the summer. Thank you for your attention in this matter.

<u>Cafeteria Charges</u>: Please note that all cafeteria charges need to be paid off by May 14. No charges will be allowed beginning May 14. To view your child's account, you may go to the online lunch payment system. This system not only allows parents to pay for lunches online, but also enables you to view your child's account balances and monitor purchases. The program can be accessed by going to www.perrysburgschools.net and clicking on the Parent Tab, then "online payment" on the pull down menu, you will be directed to payschoolscentral.com.
