Perrysburg Schools Administrative Guideline 8500D Procedure for the Collection and Payment for Charged Meals

It is the responsibility of the parents to provide for lunch for their children while at school. However, it is important to provide that children receive the nutrition they need to stay focused during the school day. This procedure shall apply in the event that a child neither has a lunch nor the funds to purchase a lunch.

Students may charge three (3) meals in succession.

There will be no charges allowed for adults. Disabled and handicapped students at all grade levels will continue to receive their school meals with no interruption while their parents are being contacted for payment.

A student's parents and Principal will all be notified of the delinquency in the student's account each time it is necessary for the student to charge a meal to give the parents time to send a check or cash to school with their child to give to the Child Nutrition Director.

Parents may also pay for school meals via the Internet through the District's website.
