- A. 2010 – 2011 Budget Reduction Plan

Public Participation

1. Denise Harris – Supporting the Art program at the Jr. High. Concerned over the impact that the reductions will have on this program.
2. Karen Cipowski-Smith – Concerned over the classroom sizes at Ft. Meigs.

REDUCTION IN FORCE – CERTIFIED BARGAINING UNIT
