**Meeting Started at 7:09 p.m.**

**Call to Order – Roll Call**

The President called the meeting to order with the following members present; Mrs. Downs, Dr. Edinger, Mrs. Hovland, Mr. Schoenlein and Mr. Van Hoozen.

**Pledge of Allegiance**

**FY08-06-003 – Adopt the Proposed Agenda**

Mr. Van Hoozen moved, seconded by Mr. Schoenlein the Board adopt the proposed agenda. The President called for the vote. Voting yes; Mr. Van Hoozen, Mr. Schoenlein, Mrs. Downs, Dr. Edinger and Mrs. Hovland. Motion carried.

**Superintendent's Report**

A. Commodore Building Update – Mr. Hosler presented a power point presentation on the development of the Commodore and the recommendations of the administration moving forward. Julie App, Duket & Porter, Architects and Chris Slagle, Attorney from Bricker & Eckler were both present and presented information on the demolition.

**Public Participation**

1. **Clint Mauk, 9430 Sheffield Drive** – Member of the Board of Directors for Historic Perrysburg. Concerned over the cost of demolition – May be more than we expect. Renovation of the 1931 portion of the Commodore may be more than we expect. We have land at the High School, why not build an administrative building there. What about the future tax revenue that the development of the Commodore site would bring if it were developed. Concerned that we have not thought this through financially and that it will impact the district in the long term regarding future levy success.
2. **Derek Schwaegerk, 160 Quail Drive, Apt #128** – Likes the idea presented. His major concern is the amount of taxes that Perrysburg School District residents pay.
3. **Gary Franks, 29479 Belmont Lake** – Wanted the board to guarantee that there would be no future commercial development on this site with the current proposal. Was concerned that the administration did not take all of the issues into account and that the demolition cost was going to exceed initial estimates. Indicated he was a certified engineer and stressed the need to be in compliance with the Ohio Revised Code.
4. **Denny Barrett, 514 W. Front St.** – Very supportive of the Board's decision. Feels that the Board has reviewed and considered every possible option and supports the Board's decision wholeheartedly.
5. **Chris Vogel, 26649 Nawash Drive** – Indicated that he was supportive of the Board's decision to raze the old Commodore. The idea of spending public money on a private project "is abhorrent to most taxpayers in this district." Shared that he felt that none of the proposals presented to the Board to preserve the property were viable and the fact that no group bid on the property during the public auction held last year and that alone should raise questions as to the financial viability of any proposed project.
6. **Sue Hoffman, 316 Hickory St.** – Complimented the Board and Administration for the time and effort that they have put into finding a suitable solution to the issue. Feels the district has made every effort to reach out to the community and that it is the school district's job to provide a safe environment to educate children.

**A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS  
OF THE PERRYSBURG EXEMPTED VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT  
THE QUESTION OF LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL TAX, PURSUANT  
TO SECTION 5705.213 OF THE REVISED CODE.**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Perrysburg Exempted Village School District, County of Wood, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Board finds, determines and declares that the amount of taxes that may be raised by the Board with the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the present and future requirements of this District, and that it is therefore necessary to levy an additional tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation in order to raise the amount of \$5,787,158 in the first year of its collection and increasing by the additional amount of \$593,184 in each of the three following years, for a total of four years, for the purpose of current expenses.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 5705.213 of the Revised Code, there shall be submitted to the electors of this District, at a special election to be held on November 4, 2008, the question of levying the additional tax described in Section 1 hereof in excess of the ten-mill limitation for a period of four years (commencing with a levy on the tax list and duplicate for the year 2008 to be first distributed to the Board in calendar year 2009) in order to raise the amount of \$5,787,158 in the first year of its collection and increasing by the additional amount of \$593,184 in each of the three following years, for a total of four years, for the purpose of current expenses, at the annual tax rates necessary to raise those amounts.

Section 3. The Treasurer is directed to certify immediately a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of Wood County for the calculation by the County Auditor of the annual levies, expressed in dollars and cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, as well as in mills for each one dollar of valuation, which will be required to produce the annual amounts set forth above, assuming that the amount of the tax list of this District remains the same throughout the life of the levy as the amount of the tax list for the current year.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
