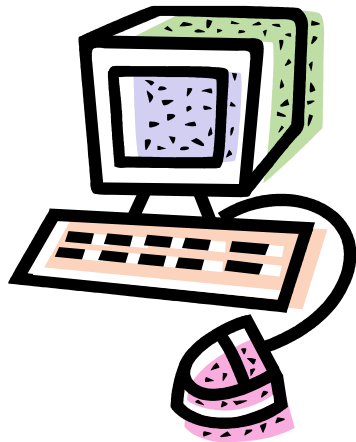

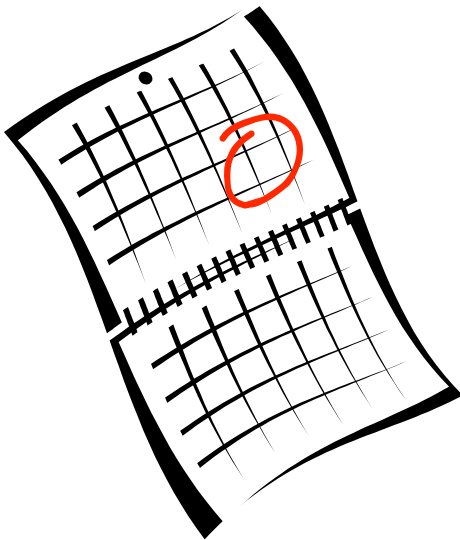

Wood County/Perrysburg Preschool Pre-Registration

The Wood County Preschool Program at Toth Elementary and Lutheran Church of the Master, operated in collaboration with the Wood County Educational Service Center, will soon be offering Pre-Registration Forms for the 2009-10 school year. The Wood County Preschool Program is nationally accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children, indicating highest quality preschool programming. The preschool programs are developmentally appropriate, play-based preschools supporting the Ohio Department of Education’s model curriculum.

The Wood County Preschool Program is an inclusionary preschool program serving children who have delays in development and children who are typically developing. Tuition, based on a sliding-fee scale, is charged for children without special-needs, and enrollment is on a first-come first-served basis. Children attend preschool four days per week Monday-Thursday during either a morning or an afternoon session.

Pre-Registration Forms for toilet trained, typically developing children will be mailed to each elementary school and the Way library. You may also obtain forms by calling Naomi at the Wood County Educational Service Center (419-354-9010, ext. 133). Questions and registration information regarding children who may have special needs can be directed to Amy Scherer, Preschool Supervisor (419-354-9010, ext. 174).

Kindergarten Registration Planned

Kindergarten registration for the 2009-2010 school year will be held at Frank Elementary on Tuesday, February 24th. In order to register your child you must provide the following information: birth certificate, social security card, proof of residency, immunization records, and proof of custody, if applicable. **As specified by board policy, proof of residency consists of a deed, building permit, rental agreement, or property tax statement.** Any child who will be five years old on or before **August 1st** is eligible to register. **The hours will be from 9:00am-12:00pm and 1:00pm-4:00pm and 5:00pm-6:00pm. Only a parent or legal guardian can register the child.**

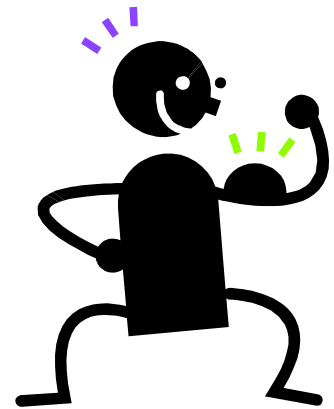
Growth & Development Classes Planned
