

**PERRYSBURG HIGH SCHOOL  
PARENT WAIVER FORM  
POST-SECONDARY OPTIONS PROGRAM**

This Parent Waiver form must be signed before any student is permitted to participate in the Post-Secondary Options Program. It is required to verify that the student and parents have received the counseling required by law prior to participating in either of the options listed below.

**OPTION A:**

The student may elect at the time of enrollment to receive college credit for the course(s) he /she takes at college while enrolled at Perrysburg High School. With this option the parent and/or student is responsible for the cost of tuition, fees, textbooks, and materials.

**OPTION B:**

The student may elect at the time of enrollment to receive credit for the course work toward fulfilling the graduation requirements of Perrysburg High School and college credit simultaneously. With this option the cost of tuition, fees, textbooks, and materials will be paid by the Perrysburg School District If, after high school graduation, the student enrolls in the same college, the college must award full college credit for all courses successfully completed under this option.

I understand the advantages, possible risks and consequences of participating in the Post-Secondary Enrollment Options described above and have received counseling which included:

1. Program eligibility;
2. Program options;
3. Financial arrangements for tuition, books, materials and fees;
4. The process of granting credit;
5. Criteria for transportation aid;
6. Available support services;
7. Scheduling;
8. The consequences of failing or not completing a course in which the student enrolls and the effect of the grade attained in the course being included in the student's grade point average;
  - a. All costs affiliated with any post-Secondary Enrollment Options coursed which the student fails to complete will be the responsibility of the student and /or his/her parents;
  - b. The final grade a student receives in any Post-Secondary Options course will be included in the students Perrysburg High School grade point average exactly as reported by the college;
9. The effect of program participation on the student's ability to complete graduation requirements;
10. The academic and social responsibilities of students and parents under the program;
11. Information about and encouragement to use the counseling services of the colleges in which the student intends to enroll;
12. Information confirming the fact that students can take college courses at no cost;
13. Encouragement to all students who have the ability to undertake college work, especially gifted students, to seriously consider the program.
