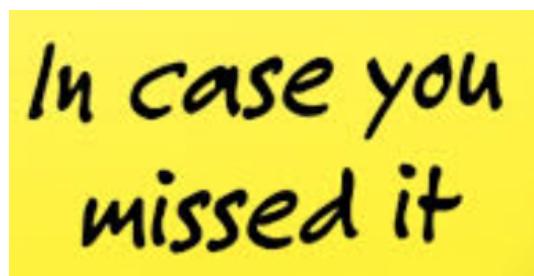

Yearbooks:

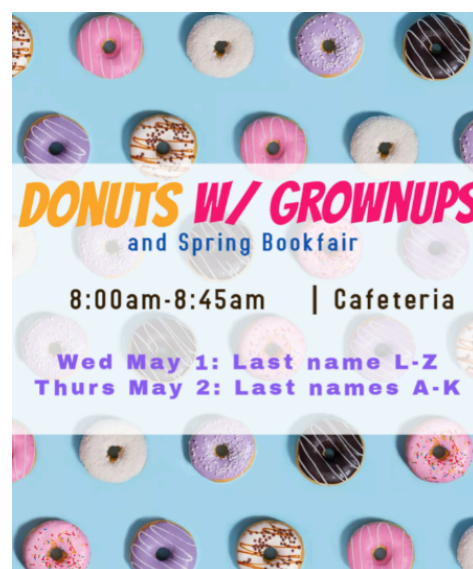
