More About Your Visit To Penta...

You're all set! Penta is waiting for you to come and visit. But now what? Here are some things you need to know in order to help make your visit successful:



1. Be sure to know where the Penta bus is parked at your high school and the time it leaves. In addition, introduce yourself to the bus driver and ask about the bus route in the afternoon.

2. School begins at Penta at 8:10 in the morning and ends at 2:55 in the afternoon.

3. When you arrive at Penta, report to the front desk on the first floor. Someone will direct you.

4. Wear clothing that is applicable for the career program which you are visiting. For example, if you are visiting a construction program, you may be visiting the job site which may be outside. Be sure to dress for the weather. In addition, students visiting a mechanical or construction program need to wear leather shoes or boots instead of tennis shoes. Sweats, flip-flops, shorts and hats may not be worn to Penta.

5. A complimentary standard school lunch will be provided for you. You may also purchase a la carte items on a cost per item basis. See your high school counselor if you are on a free or reduced lunch program.

6. If you are unable to go to Penta on your scheduled day, be sure to notify your high school counselor before school begins.

7. If your home school is delayed or canceled, you will be rescheduled.

8. Be sure to check with all your high school teachers for homework assignments prior to your visit to Penta.

9. Your visit to Penta is designed to assist you in making your decision about attending Penta next year. Ask lots of questions. Ask about potential jobs, attendance requirements, uniform needs, the academic part of the day, etc. Gather as much information as you can; then make the choices that are best for you and your future.

That's about it. All that's left is for you to enjoy your visit and learn more about the career options available at Penta. Have fun and good luck in making your career choice.
