



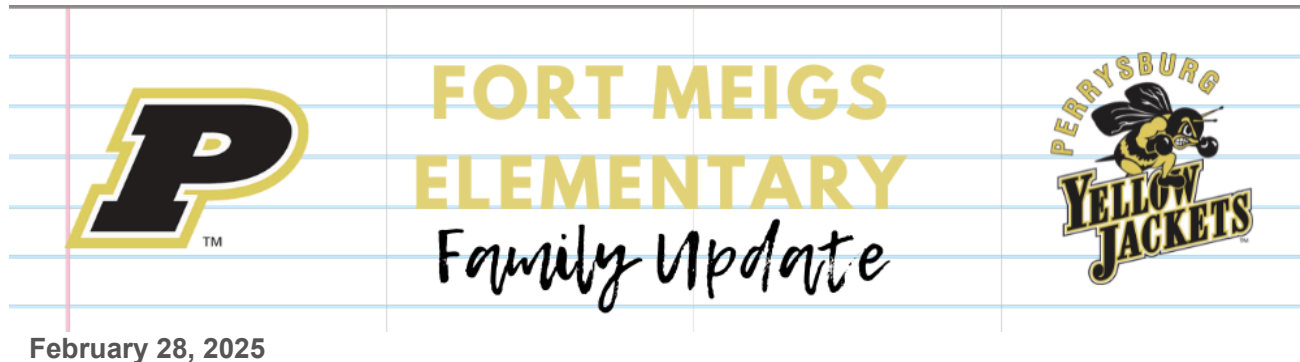

Being around loud noise for long periods of time can cause Noise Induced Hearing Loss. Once you lose your hearing, you cannot get it back.

According to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC):

- Five in 10 young people listen to their music or other audio too loudly.
- Four in 10 young people are around dangerously loud noises during events like concerts and sports games.
- In the U.S., 48 million people have trouble hearing with one (or both) of their ears.

World Hearing Day is a day to learn how to prevent hearing loss and promote healthy hearing. Some easy tips, if it is too loud and you cannot carry on a conversation, you are in an environment that can damage your hearing. Walk away from the sound, turn down the sound, or use hearing protection to reduce the sound coming into your ears.
