# Jacket Jump Start Conferences:

- In lieu of a separate preparation day and building preview night, Jacket Jump Start Conferences provide an opportunity for K-4th grade homeroom teachers to meet with families individually and assess students during 30-minute appointments. This will give families and students a special time to get to know teachers, see the classroom, drop off supplies, and tour the building.
- Directions on signing up for the conference will accompany the email on August 2nd at 4 p.m. Should you have any questions please contact your teacher or the office directly.
- Jacket Jump Start Conferences will be held on August 13, 14, and 15 and there is no school for students on these days. Stay tuned for more details via the August 2nd email.

#### Final Forms Material:

- All back to school forms are to be completed through FinalForms. Please review and/or update your information as soon as possible to ensure accuracy and sign annual back to school consent forms for the 2024-2025 school year. Changes in custody or residency will require supporting documentation to be uploaded in FinalForms or emailed to a school secretary. #### Arrival:

- Our building doors open at 8:50 a.m. with school beginning at 9:05.
- Please note that students who are dropped off prior to 8:50 a.m. will be unsupervised outside. Our staff will be on duty daily beginning at 8:50.
- Upon arrival at school, students should immediately enter the building and begin to report to their homerooms. The exception would be if a student purchases a school breakfast. Breakfast is available for students between 8:50 a.m 9:03 a.m. daily in the cafeteria. Pricing can be found at <a href="Child Nutrition Services Link">Child Nutrition Services Link</a>.
- Parents should note that students should <u>NOT</u> be dropped off in the parking lot on Fort Meigs Road. Our buses use this parking lot for quick and efficient drop off for our students who ride buses and dropping students off in this parking lot creates a significant safety concern. Please use the parking lot on Eckel Junction Road for dropping off students who are brought to school in a vehicle by families or caretakers. Thank you for your understanding.

## August 16th - First Day - Parent Drop-off Information:

• At the elementary level the first day of school can be an exciting (and anxious) time for all students and their families. Though we want to be mindful of this excitement (and anxiety) we wanted to make sure that families were aware that we are only allowing families to walk their child (if desired or needed) to their classrooms on August 16th. We strongly encourage parents and family members to say their goodbyes outside of the school building on the first day to help set a routine and develop good habits.

#### Dismissal:

- Please be patient during our dismissal times.
- We are a school building of nearly 600 elementary students on a daily basis! During dismissal please understand that we will have walkers, car riders, and bus riders that will be learning a new routine and often need many reminders about safety. Thanks for your understanding.
- The pick-up line will continue to be the same as it has been in the past. This year, 4th grade will line up closest to Eckel Junction Road, then 3rd, 2nd, 1st, and Kindergarten. The attached map indicates the pick-up line area and where families should plan to pick their children up. Adults should not exit their vehicles while in the car line.
- Car riders should only enter their vehicles through the car door closest to the sidewalk. We are asking that drivers who are picking up students please place a sign in your front windshield that indicates your child(ren)'s name(s) and the grade the child attends for the first two weeks of school. For example, a sign that says "Jim Smith, First Grade" on the dashboard will allow our car



pick-up line to move more smoothly and decrease the amount of time it takes to get through the pick-up line as we begin the new year.

- For those parents who pick their student(s) up to walk home with them, please be mindful and plan ahead with your child(ren) regarding the general area where you will pick them up after school. This will create efficiency in dismissal. On the attached map, you will see an area designated as "Walker Pick-Up Area". Staff will be directing students to this area to begin walking home.
- Bus riders, as indicated on the map, will continue to be in the same area as in the past on the east side of the building.
- Parents should note that students should <u>NOT</u> be picked-up in the parking lot on Fort Meigs Road. Our buses use this parking lot for quick and efficient dismissal procedures for our students who ride buses and picking-up students in this parking lot creates a significant safety concern. Please use the parking lot on Eckel Junction Road or Rivercrest Park for picking up students at the end of the day.

# Family Updates/Communication:

- This year we will continue to send family updates to all families on Friday mornings. Our first family update will be on August 23.
- It is vital that your contact information is up-to-date in our office. # Use of Personal Communication Devices

• If possible, please leave any personal communication devices at home (phones, watches, tablets, etc). If a device is brought to school, it will need to be silenced and placed in the student's locker. Please keep in mind that our elementary lockers do not have locks.

### New ELA Curriculum, Wit & Wisdom:

• This year Perrysburg Schools will implement a new ELA curriculum in alignment with the Science of Reading titled, Wit & Wisdom. This curriculum adoption will take place in grades K-6. More information is available in the Wit & Wisdom FM Building Letter.

### Parties:

• Three school parties are typically scheduled each school year. They are scheduled for Halloween, Winter Holiday and Valentine's Day. These parties will be held at a time determined by the classroom teacher. In addition, we will also celebrate our year's accomplishments by having an end-of-the-year party. Parent/guardian participation will be limited to those who sign-up to volunteer prior to the classroom party.

# Distribution of Edible Treats:

• In an effort to nurture healthy food choices as well as protecting an increasing number of students with food allergies, we will continue to not distribute edible treats inside of our school building. This year the practice will occur in all Perrysburg elementary buildings. We appreciate your partnership as we continue to implement this practice. Additionally, please do not send gifts to school. The school day will not be interrupted to deliver gifts (balloons, flowers, etc.).

# Safety Information:

• School and student safety continues to be paramount inside of our daily routines. As is required by law we will conduct monthly drills that involve fire, tornado (spring), and lockdown drills throughout the school year. Our staff works closely with our students to discuss safety and what to do if an emergency arises. We discuss the social story "I'm Not Scared, I'm Prepared" with our students and consistently revisit safety measures that are put in place to keep our students familiar and comfortable with our procedures. Throughout the year we will remind families of upcoming or completed drills and we always encourage conversations with our young people regarding safety.

# "The Jacket Way":

- The Perrysburg Schools are committed to The Jacket Way. The Jacket Way at Fort Meigs Elementary is based upon the Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) model which sets out student and adult expectations to create a culture best suited for students to be academically, emotionally, and socially successful. The Jacket Way encompasses the three R's:
  - Respectful
  - Responsible
  - Ready

- Students are expected to be Respectful, Responsible, and Ready throughout the building. Behavior expectations have been created and are taught to students so they understand these expectations over the course of the first few weeks of school and throughout the school year.

## Transportation:

- Per our transportation guidelines, students are not permitted to ride buses to which they are not assigned.

## School Health Aide:

Fort Meigs is lucky to have Mrs. Corinna Lintner, RN, as our School Health Aide. ### **Encore classes:**

- Our Encore classes are Library, Art, Music, STEM, and Physical Education.
- Encore classes will take place daily. Encore teachers will be teaching students their content inside of a 45-minute period within the students' homeroom classes.
- Encore classes may, weather permitting, head outside for their classes and will return to their homeroom classes at the end of the Encore period. Please plan to dress accordingly for each respective Encore class.
- Attention 3rd and 4th grade families:
  - Students in Mr. George's music class will need to have a recorder. They can be purchased in the music room for \$5 during Jacket Jump Start (except August 15th) or during the first week of school. Students will begin using recorders in class the 3rd week of school.

#### Recess:

- Students will have a daily thirty-minute (30) recess.
- As with Encore classes above, recess will provide a time for a break from the general education classroom. Please be mindful of the weather and have your child(ren) dress appropriately each day. As you know, the weather of northwest Ohio can, and often does, change throughout the day. We will do our best to ensure that students get outside as much as possible for recess.
- Oftentimes a class may use an "additional" recess based on the schedule and/or class rewards. When these occur, a specific schedule will be developed.

### Weather:

• We will do our best to ensure that students get outside as much as possible for recess. Students should be dressed appropriately in their daily attendance and plan to be outside as long as the temperature is above 15 degrees.

#### Attendance:

- In the event that you need to call your child(ren) off of school, please report your absence prior to the start of the day. Our building doors open at 8:50 a.m. with school beginning at 9:05. If your child arrives after 9:05, please enter the main office (off of Fort Meigs Road) and complete the sign-in sheet to receive a pass to class.
- Perrysburg Schools does have a <u>Pre-planned Absence Form</u> for those situations when families know, in advance, that they will be away from school.

- Students will be permitted to bring their own water bottles for daily use.
- As a reminder we do not allow outside restaurant food to be delivered inside of our cafeteria. Further, please try to limit carbonated beverages that your child brings to school with their lunches. Lunch time can be an excellent time for students to socialize and be with their classmates. We do not encourage families to attend lunch with their child(ren) for this purpose and ask that you limit attending lunch with your child(ren) to an extremely limited basis. In the event of a special occasion (birthday, military family member returning home, out of town relative, etc.) arrangements may be made to eat with your child away from the cafeteria setting.
