Student Schedules

Additional School Day Information

- The building is open for student arrival at 7:00 a.m. Students who arrive before 7:35 a.m. will wait in the gym until being dismissed to go to their lockers. Breakfast is available in the Commons between 7:15-7:45 am.
- School begins at 7:50 a.m. ***Students are expected to be seated in their homerooms at this time.***
- The HPI school day is divided into four core classes (ELA, Math, Science & Social Studies), homeroom/Jacket Period, a creative arts block (Art, IDEA, PE, & STEM), an exploratory elective block (Performing Arts & Exploratory class options) and a lunch/recess block.

School Start Date

The HPI school year begins with a staggered start. This allows students to get acclimated or reacclimated to the school with only one grade level in the building to start the new school year.
