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### **Medication at School**

All medication given in school requires Perrysburg District forms to be completed. This includes both prescription and over the counter medications. In the elementary schools, cough drops and throat drops fall under the category of "over the counter medications". According to the district medication policy, only medication that has to be given during school hours will be considered. Medications must be labeled with the child's full name, brought to school by an adult and may not be sent to school in a child's lunch box, pocket, or backpack.
