What is the National Guard?

The National Guard is a unique part-time force of the United States Army. Soldiers serve one weekend a month and two weeks a year. The National Guard is mobilized during times of war, national emergencies, and serves our state and local communities during emergencies and times of need.



What can the Army National Guard do for you?



Pay

Soldiers are paid for serving one weekend a month. Entry level pay ranges from **\$224(E1)-\$292(E4)** per month as well as fulltime active duty pay for two-weeks annual training.

Soldiers are paid **\$1680(E1)-\$2194(E4)** per month fulltime active duty pay while attending basic training.



THE BIG DOG!

100% College Tuition

The Ohio National Guard Scholarship program pays **100%** college tuition to state-assisted institutions. Program pays equivalent to private colleges.

Split Option Program

Allows high school and college students to enlist without interrupting their education. Soldiers start by attending basic training during the summer, return to resume school while training one weekend a month at RSP and then completes their job specialty training the following summer. This option is also available to seasonal workers.



Recruit Sustainment Program (RSP)

Newly enlisted Soldiers get paid while they serve in the RSP one weekend a month until they ship to basic training. RSP prepares Soldiers to meet the physical and mental rigors of basic training.



Job Training and Real World Experience

A soldiers' leadership abilities, work ethic, teamwork and dedication translate into the skills employers consider to be invaluable.



Health Insurance

Soldiers may purchase a premium-based health insurance plan that. Individual coverage is **\$57.00** a month and family coverage **\$202.00** a month.

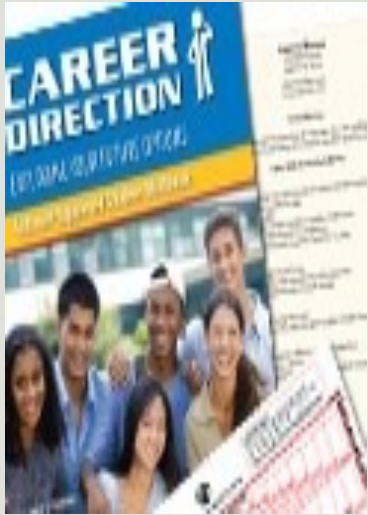

SO WHAT WOULD A SIX YEAR CONTRACT LOOK LIKE ?

YEAR 1 – 22 DAYS OF DRILL + 10 WEEKS OF BCT

- DRILL = \$2,222.00 + BCT = \$3,828.75 = \$6,050.75

YEAR 2 – (E-2) 22 DRILL DAYS + 8 WEEKS OF AIT

- DRILL = \$2,508.00 + AIT = \$3,436.00 = \$5,944.00

YEAR 3 – (E-3) 22 DRILL DAYS + 15 DAYS AT

- DRILL = \$2805.00 + AT = \$960.00 = \$3,765.00

YEAR 4 – (E-3) 22 DRILL DAYS + 15 DAYS AT
