

## CONSTRUCTION UNDER WAY FOR HULL PRAIRIE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL

Ground was broken for Hull Prairie Intermediate School in June with the opening planned for the beginning of the 2017-18 school year. The school will serve students in grades 5 and 6, alleviating overcrowding at five of the district's six schools by removing 5th grade from the elementary schools and 6th grade from the junior high school.

**Bond Projects Completed This Summer Include:** auxiliary gym at PHS, completion of air conditioning at PJHS, supplemental heat at Frank Elementary School, and elementary secure entry vestibules.

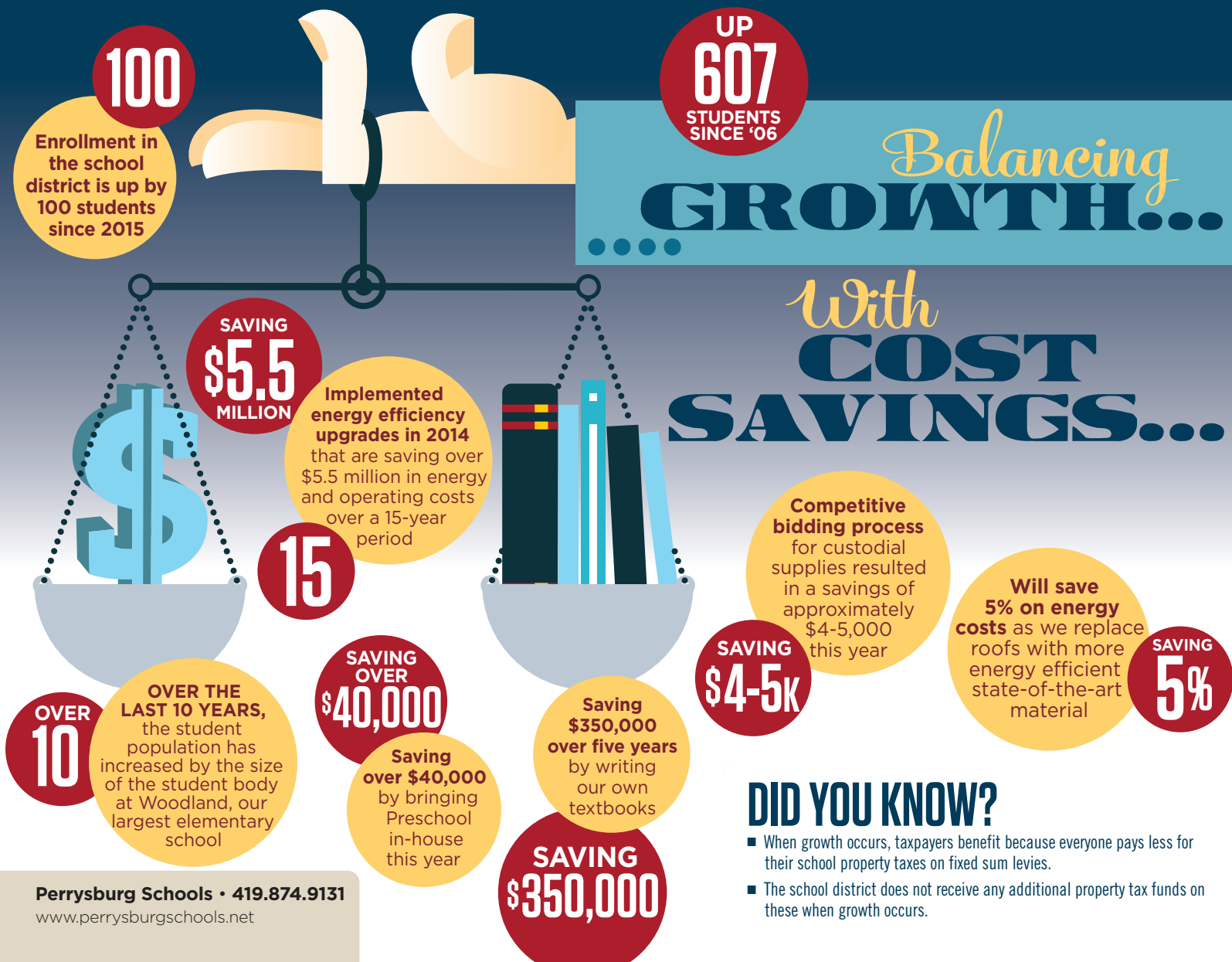

## Academics

Our school district's academic program is designed to ensure all students achieve their greatest potential.

**51 students** are currently taking college-level courses **through College Credit Plus**.

Perrysburg Schools received an A for Progress in Value-Added in the State Report Card released in September. Value-added looks at how well we're doing with student academic progress year-to-year. Our overall value-added index was the **fourth highest in the state**.

PHS had **5 Commended Scholars and 1 Finalist on the 2016 National Merit Qualifying Test**.

**3 dual enrollment, 13 advanced placement and 13 honors courses** are offered.

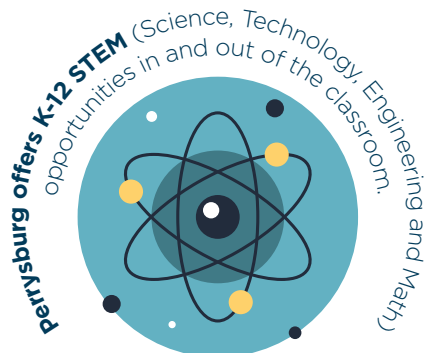
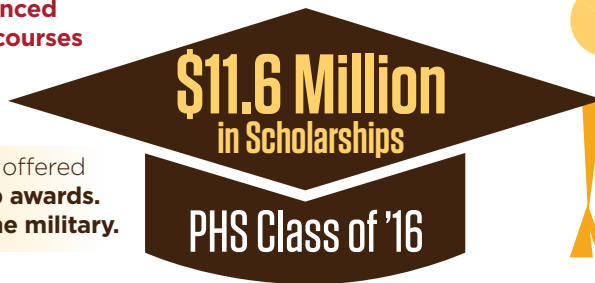
The PHS Class of 2016 was offered **\$11.6 million in scholarship awards**. **92% go on to college or the military**.

# Fiscal Stewardship

Financial responsibility ensures that the majority of funding is spent on classroom instruction.

\$1.75M

**\$1.75 million** has been donated to our school district since the establishment of our Development Department in Fall 2013.

The school district saved local taxpayers **\$2.3 million** over the next **10 years** due to aggressive refinancing of bonds this summer.

The school district is collecting **0.59 BELOW** expected millage from local taxpayers on the current levy due to the recent refinancing, favorable interest rates and increases in valuation.

The school district is asking voters to renew our current operating levy as a continuing levy on November 8, keeping it the same rate it is today. This is not a new tax and is 26.8% of our total annual revenue. The State currently pays \$1.2 million of our local taxpayers' share, but due to the phase-out of this rollback, our taxpayers would have to pay this portion instead on any levy moving forward. **By making this a continuing levy, it locks in the \$1.2 million in State rollback funds permanently, keeping more dollars in our taxpayers' pockets.**

Perrysburg, considered a high wealth school district by the state, receives **27%** of our funding from the state compared to the state average of **46%**.

Fitch Ratings has affirmed Perrysburg Schools' unlimited tax general obligation (ULTGO) bonds at 'A+' and revised the rating outlook from stable to positive.



During the 2013-14 school year, a system to compensate teachers based on performance was implemented. It is offered on an opt-in basis to teachers, and **71%** currently participate.

## Services

A variety of services provide options to ensure all students receive individualized instruction, enrichment and support.



**99%** of Teachers are Skilled or Accomplished based on their evaluations.

**63.7%** of our teachers have at least a Master's Degree.

The Jacket Way, was rolled out to all students this school year, creates common expectations for behavior and focuses on the three R's: Respectful, Responsible and Ready. It reflects the Olweus Bullying Prevention Program and the work of our school district's Diversity Committee.

The school district hired Ohio Coalition for Autism and Low Incidence to review our special education programs. They recommended additional, specialized support in behavior, transition planning between grades and post-school and assistive technology. The District Leadership Team is now developing a plan for implementing improvements to address each finding.

In the latest Wood County Youth Survey, students smoking tobacco, using marijuana and experiencing bullying in Perrysburg Schools has decreased significantly.

From 2003-2015, our English as a Second Language program serviced students speaking a total of 21 languages, from Arabic to Russian.

In 2009, a student drug-testing program was implemented for athletes to provide another reason to say no.

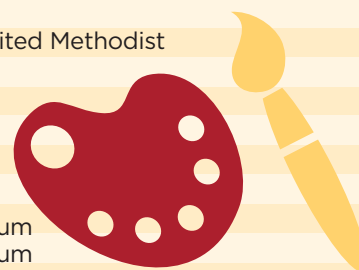
