Dear Parent or Guardian,

As we plan for the 2023-2024 school year, we wanted to take this time to share with you some important dates. Perrysburg High School Back-To-School forms for grades 9-12 for the 2023-24 school year will again be accessed through FinalForms. The online registration for the 2023-24 school year is available now for you to begin filling out the forms. This system is for all PHS students, including our Penta Career Center students, and is no longer exclusive to just our athletes.

This online registration is a requirement for all parents/guardians of new or returning 9-12 students. This MUST be completed by a parent or guardian, and the student will also sign the forms after the forms are completed by the parent or guardian. The student will receive a notification email to his or her school email to sign the forms. FinalForms collects the information the school uses to communicate with parents and guardians via email and phone and needs to be updated annually by the parent/guardian. Please make sure to completely fill out all the information, especially the page regarding Agreements and Permissions. If you have a returning student, this is the same email and password that you have used in the past. If you have forgotten your password, there is a "forgot password" field at the bottom of the screen that you may use to reset your password. Once you have logged in, you will see the box to register for the 2023-2024 school year.

All parents/guardians and students must complete the online registration by Monday, July 31, 2023.

Laptop pickup information for incoming 5th, 9th grade and any new students to the school district in grades 6, 7, 8, 10, 11 and 12 will be available by the end of July.

## LINK CREW ORIENTATION (FRESHMEN ONLY)

Link Crew Orientation will be held on Tuesday, August 15th for 9th graders with the last name A-K, and Wednesday, August 16th for 9th graders with the last name L-Z. This orientation is the first required day of the school year for 9th graders only. The day is scheduled from 8:30 a.m. - 3:25 p.m.; buses will be running on a regular schedule. More specifics regarding the details of the day will be sent out at the end of July.

# 2022-2023 YEARBOOK DISTRIBUTION

Yearbooks will be distributed to students who pre-ordered them on Wednesday, August 23 and Wednesday, August 30 from 1:45-3:30 (this is period 11 and the early release period). Students will need to present a photo ID to receive their book. A limited supply of extra copies of 2022-2023 yearbooks will be available for purchase for \$85 per book on a first-come, first-served basis. Graduated seniors will have their books mailed home over the summer.

### INDIVIDUAL YEARBOOK PHOTOGRAPHS & STUDENT IDS

Professional photographers from JPix will be taking pictures of our Penta Career Center students, Grade 9 students and any new high school student grades (10-12) at the Link Crew orientation days on <u>August 15 and August 16</u>. Current PHS students in Grades 10-12 or any student who may have missed the Link Crew orientation days will be photographed on <u>September 25</u> during the student lunches or during the morning study halls. The pictures will be for Student IDs and for inclusion in the PHS yearbook. <u>Note: Student IDs are necessary for Penta Career Center students and other PHS students who plan to attend Athletic events and participate in Athletics.</u> The ordering information for school pictures for freshmen, sophomores and juniors will be sent to parents/guardians after picture day.

## SENIOR YEARBOOK PORTRAITS

It's a tradition at PHS for seniors to be photographed in a formal setting. Impulse Studio is scheduled to take portraits of the Class of 2024 on **July 27**, **28**, **and 31**, **2023** at PHS in the Auxiliary Gym (door 44). Appointments take just 5 minutes and are free of charge. Please book your rising senior's appointment as soon as possible by clicking <a href="here">here</a>. If your rising senior will not be in town or cannot be photographed on these July dates, plan on being photographed Tuesday, November 7, 2023. A sign up sheet for the makeup date will come out this fall. Please be aware that seniors are expected to dress appropriately in these portraits. This means collared shirts, suit jackets optional. No spaghetti straps, halter tops or strapless shirts. The photographer offers the "black drape" top for a more classic look. Hats are not permitted in senior portraits.
