





Before you know it, you'll be receiving your high school diploma. Ohio is giving you new ways to show the world what you can do with it.

As a student entering ninth grade on or after **July 1, 2019**, Ohio's new high school graduation requirements give you more flexibility to choose a graduation pathway that builds on your strengths and passions — one that ensures you are ready for your next steps and excited about the future.

First, cover the basics

rou must earn a minimum total of 20 credits in specified subjects and take your required tests. Then, decide how you will round out your diploma requirements.

Other Requirements

You also must receive instruction in economics and financial inersoy and complete at least two semesters of fine arts. Your district may require more than 20 credits to graduate.

Earn a passing sept of Ohio's high school Algebra I and English II tests. Students who do not pass the test will be offered additional support and must retake the test at least once.
