An excellent place to live and work, Perrysburg is located in northwestern Ohio. It is a charming community with a small city atmosphere, nestled on the shore of the Maumee River. Perrysburg High School is a four-year public comprehensive high school that offers a challenging college preparatory program. Enrollment is 1,828 with approximately 167 students attending our vocational/technical affiliate, Penta Career Center. The graduating class of 2024 totaled 425. Perrysburg High School serves as an ACT Test Center.

ACHIEVEMENTS

- Perrysburg Schools achieved a Performance Index (PI) score of 102.8 (94%) on the 2024 State Report Card,
 which is the 40th Best in the State of Ohio out of 607 districts Top 7% in the State!
- Perrysburg Schools has earned the Best Communities for Music Education designation from The NAMM Foundation every year since 2007.
- Perrysburg High School has again been named among the Best High Schools by U.S. News. PHS is ranked #26 in Ohio and #698 in the national rankings.
- PHS named #2,667 in Newsweek's Top 5,000 STEM High Schools.
- Perrysburg High School has earned the Ohio Department of Education's Purple Star designation, which
 recognizes the schools' commitment to serving military-connected students and families.
- According to Niche's 2023 Best Schools, Perrysburg Schools ranks #17 out of 608 school districts for Best School
 Districts in Ohio, which is based upon rigorous analysis of data and reviews.
- Eighteen Advanced Placement and sixteen honors courses are offered.
- In 2023-24, 299 students took 523 AP tests with 92% scoring 3 or above.
- 58 Perrysburg High School juniors were inducted into membership in the National Honor Society in Spring 2023.
- Class of 2024 was offered over \$22.7 million in scholarship awards.

CURRICULUM & FACULTY

- The Curriculum consists of college preparatory, pre-vocational and technical preparatory.
- Dual enrollment courses are offered in Education, French, Physics, Spanish and World Civilizations through Bowling Green State University. Business Marketing courses are offered through Owens Community College.
- AP Courses offered include: American Government, American History, Art History, Biology, Calculus (AB and BC), Chemistry, Chinese, Computer Science, English Literature, European History, French, Music Theory, Physics C, Psychology, Spanish, Statistics and 2D Studio Art and Design.
- Perrysburg is a member school of Penta Career Center. Students at Perrysburg High School can apply for
 admission to any of Penta's career and technical training programs. Penta's programs prepare students for
 college, careers, the military, additional certifications or wherever their paths may lead. Penta currently offers 30
 career-technical programs for students in areas such as marketing, business, health, construction, manufacturing,
 human services, agriculture and transportation. FREE College Credit Plus options are also available to students.
 Penta also offers the Sophomore Exploratory program and the Sophomore Advanced Manufacturing Academy for
 students interested in exploring a variety of career options.
- High school students who participate in interscholastic activities, marching band, dance team, or cheerleading for at least two full seasons may be excused from the traditional high school physical education requirement.
