#### First Week of School

As a reminder, Perrysburg Junior High conducts a staggered start to the academic year. Start days will follow the schedule below:

Tuesday, August 16 - 8th grade students only.

Wednesday, August 17 - 7th grade students only.

Thursday, August 18 - Both 7th and 8th grade students.

Our 7th Grade First Day of School will be led by our PJHS WEB Program. The WEB Program is a peer mentorship program focused on creating positive transitions to 7th grade. The WEB Program features roughly 70 8th Grade WEB Leaders that will lead all 7th graders in small group activities along with whole group activities in our gymnasium and classrooms. Students will then have an opportunity to follow their schedule and meet all of their teachers.

Once school begins on August 16 the building will open for students to enter at 7:15 a.m. and students who are dropped off, walking or riding their bike will report to either the auxiliary gym or the auditorium until 7:30 a.m. Students who ride the bus to school will remain on their buses until 7:30 a.m. At that time, students are released to report to their lockers, eat breakfast in the cafeteria and go to their Period 1 class. Our Period 1 begins at 7:50 a.m. with announcements occurring shortly before then. Students are dismissed at 2:45 p.m.

Students schedules are broken down into a seven period day. All students will be enrolled in a Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and English Language Arts class. 7th Grade Students are also required to be enrolled in a semester of Health and a semester of Physical Education. All students will conclude their day with a 25 minute Jacket Period that is designed for Meaningful Silent Reading or for teachers to provide additional academic support to students.

Students will have a 30 minute lunch period which is determined by their course schedule. Requests for specific student lunch periods will only be made for a documented medical condition.
