

From the Clinic

Attention Parents/Guardians:

I will be starting Vision Screenings soon for the 2024-2025 school year. All kindergarten, first and third grade students, as well as any student new to the Perrysburg School District this year will be screened as required by state law. Vision screenings are scheduled for kindergarten, first and third grades on Tuesday October 8th and Wednesday October 9th. Students who wear prescription eyewear should make sure to bring their glasses with them every day as they will be screened with their glasses on. If you have a concern regarding your child's vision, please let me know. School vision screening is not a replacement for a thorough eye exam done by a licensed eye care specialist.

Why is it important to have your child's vision screened?

Young children with vision problems do not know the way that they see the world is not the way they should be seeing it! Without early detection and treatment, children's vision problems can lead to permanent vision loss and learning difficulties. 80% of learning occurs through the visual system.

If your child does not pass the vision screening, you will be notified with a recommendation for further evaluation by an eye care specialist.
