Welcome to your Way Public Library Student Account! Way Library is delighted to partner with Hull Prairie and The High School to serve students by providing access to library materials and electronic resources. The following guidelines have been established for the use of the Student Library Account.

- 1. All students will have a Student Library Account unless a parent or guardian has signed a waiver supplied by the school to opt out of participation. The student's Library Account number will be a 14-digit number beginning with <u>24298</u> and followed by the <u>9-digit Student ID number</u> assigned by the school.
- 2. The Student Library Account Pin # is <u>1111</u>. If you wish to change the pin number, you may contact Way Library to do so.
- 3. There is no physical library card associated with the Student Library Account.
- 4. The Student Library Account may be accessed online at <u>waylibrary.info</u> at any time to review the account, to use online databases and other resources, or to request library materials. Students may request any library materials they wish (excluding the *Beyond Books* collection) based on Way Library's Unrestricted Access Policy.
- 5. All items requested on the Student Library Account will be delivered to HPI or PHS. Students will pick up their requested items at the school and return them to the school after using them. Items requested on the Student Library Account will not be available for pick-up at Way Library.
- 6. No overdue fines will be assessed for items borrowed on the Student Library Account. Any items eligible for renewal will be renewed automatically. If an item is not returned by its final due date, use of the Student Library Account will be restricted until the overdue item is returned.
- 7. The Student Library Account provides access to all databases available to Way Library patrons. This includes Overdrive and Hoopla (for ebooks, audiobooks, music, and streaming video).
- 8. *The Student Library Account is not designed for use at Way Library.* Students wishing to visit Way Library in person to check out items or use the computers will need to use a valid Way Library card. A student without a Way Library card may apply for one in person at the library with a parent or guardian present.
- 9. The Student Library Account will remain active until the student's last day of enrollment at HPI or PHS. At that time, the account will automatically convert to an Ecard, with access to electronic resources only.
